



CENTRAL HEATING

The Lodge and East Wing have oil-fired central heating and hot water.

The Lodge has a large hot water cylinder, whilst the East Wing has a combi-boiler.

The timers are situated in the respective kitchens. On your arrival they will be set to come on twice – early morning and afternoon. This also applies to the hot water in the Lodge, whilst the East Wing has constant hot water.

If you wish to have the heating on outside the set times in the Lodge press the ‘extra hour’ button on the programmer. Likewise for hot water. In the East Wing click the ‘advance’ switch. There is no need to touch the hot water button.

Please do not alter any settings.

If a particular room is too hot, adjustment can be made by way of the thermostatic valve on each radiator.
